

Sign up for all events outside the lobby. Off-Cay events, please sign up the day before so we can confirm reservations. Feel free to show up spontaneously even if you are not signed up. You're always welcome to join us if we have room. ***The Scuba Dive Intro, Kayak Tour and Sunset Sail Lesson are dependent on participation, therefore it is necessary to sign up and follow complete instructions below.*** Keep your eye on the bulletin board outside the lobby for special events. Or tune to Ch. 2 on your television for the Hotel on the Cay Network. Ch. 2 will list daily events and run special programming about St. Croix. Most weeks remain the same, but there may be some minor changes. If you need a taxi, come to the front desk and your ride will be arranged.

Wireless Internet is now available on the Cay. Most rooms receive a signal. If you do not, please go to the covered terrace next to the HM building to receive the best signal. If you did not bring your laptop there is a computer available for internet use in the first floor of the HM building in the lounge area. The lounge is now open to relax and enjoy our library, tv, board games, etc.

Weekly Events

SATURDAY

Take this day to relax and get acquainted with the beach. Indulge in a light fare at the Harbormaster Beach Bar. Serving breakfast and lunch daily from 8 a.m. until around 4 p.m. (the bar is open later). Explore our island. Keep an eye out for the St. Croix Ground Lizard, an endangered species that lives only three places on the face of the earth: here, Green Cay, and Ruth Cay. Learn more about the lizards on our activities board.

SUNDAY

Welcome to the Cay - 10 AM on the Terrace. Enjoy fruit juice, mimosas, and pastries while learning about St. Croix and our activities this week. Meet fellow guests and make plans together. Immediately following will be the...

Grocery Trip to Pueblo Super Market – 11 AM. Meet on the dock. Sign up by 10 a.m. so we can be sure our driver is available. St. Croix Blues Society – 5:00 PM – Live Blues at the Golden Rail Café in Gallows Bay Marina – Come join local musicians jamming classic blues tunes. Dinner, dancing, and drinks are all served up at the Golden Rail Café. Dress is casual and most meals are \$10 - \$20. Meet on our dock by 5:00PM, there is only one ferry ride over and one ferry ride back, so don't be late. The ferry will make the one pickup at the Golden Rail promptly at 8:15 PM; otherwise you will have to take a taxi back to the Cay. Enjoy your Sunday!

MONDAY

Kayak Relay Race - 11 am. At Cruzan Watersports on our beach. Fun for all ages and experience levels. If you have never been kayaking before the instructors at Cruzan Watersports will give you a brief introduction. Then two teams will compete for the Cay Kayaking Championship.

TUESDAY

RCI Exchange Guest Information Meeting – 10 AM at the Harbormaster Restaurant. We want you to enjoy your stay on St. Croix and here at Hotel on the Cay. Come and meet our General Manager Marion Hazlewood.

Island Tour with Sweeney – 10 AM Meet on King Street. Sweeney gives you a tour full of insights to the island that only a West Indian can share. See St. Croix, including Christiansted, Frederiksted, The Cruzan Rum Distillery, Whim Greathouse Plantation Museum, The Botanical Gardens, the Rain Forest, Columbus Landing, and, if you ask him nicely, the Domino Club, home of the legendary beer drinking pig. The back of the Cay is an excellent location for snorkeling. Rays, dolphin, turtles, seahorses, squid, octopus, mermaids, and numerous fish are spotted daily. This is a chance for the experienced snorkeler to go out with a group, as well as an opportunity for beginners to try it out. Peter will be happy to take you through the basics in the shallow water near the back seawall. Children should be accompanied by an adult.

THURSDAY

Kayaking of Salt River. 8:15 AM (3 Hours) ***Call Directly 778-1522 ***

Paddle the tranquil, protected waters of Salt River National Park and enjoy the area's unique combination of ecological, historical and cultural highlights. You will explore birding areas, mangrove groves, observe ancient Indian burial grounds, sunbathe, hike and swim on a pristine secluded beach. You will paddle to Columbus' landing site just as his crew did 500

years ago. The calm waters of Salt River make this a great kayaking experience for beginners and experts alike! Water and snack provided. \$45 with free transportation. Please call by 2 p.m. on Wednesday for arrangements and to leave a credit card number for your deposit. Let them know you're part of the Hotel on the Cay deal. The crew will pick you up in a white van near the Scale House gate.

Sunset Sail in Christiansted Harbor—4:30 until 6:30. ***Call Directly 773-4709***. Under the direction of Annapolis Sailing School on the boardwalk just past *Angry Nates Restaurant*. This is a hands-on experience for beginning sailors. Or if you would just like to sit back, cruise the harbor, and enjoy sunset, the instructor will do all the work. Suggested donation is \$20 per person, but larger donations can be made to help us develop the young sailors of St. Croix. Half Day and Full day trips are also available through the sailing school. Information is also available for guests who may want to set up more lessons and coordinate sailing trips in the future. A credit card deposit is required. Call 773-4709.

FRIDAY

Sail the Schooner Roseway – A historic 110ft. long 83 year old racing and fishing vessel. The Roseway offers day sails and sunset sails daily. Call 340 - 626 - 7877. The cost is \$45 adults \$30 kids. It is anchored behind the Cay in Gallows Bay. Go take a look at it.
